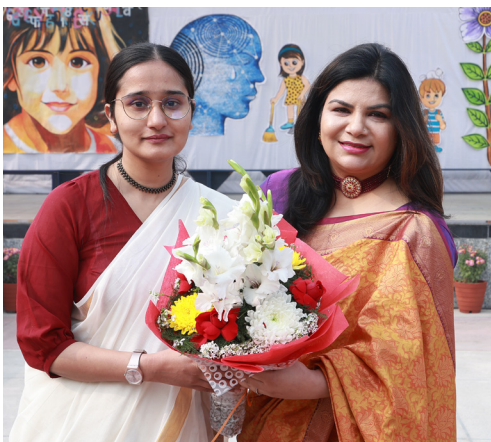

# AN UNFORGETTABLE BLEND OF FUN AND FRIENDSHIP

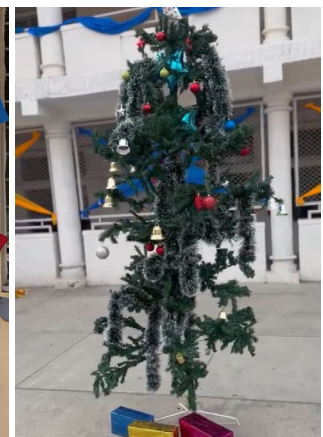
